

Title: Supporting the Yazidi Community: a survivor of Daesh captivity speaks in Parliament

Nadia Murad, a 21 year old Yazidi woman, who was previously taken as a sex slave by Daesh, will be visiting the UK next week and has agreed to meet with Parliamentarians and others to discuss ways in which the UK Government can support the Yazidi Community. Nadia spoke powerfully at the United Nations Security Council and has been widely praised for her outstanding campaign raising awareness of the issues affecting her community in Iraq and Syria. Many have advocated for Nadia to receive the Nobel peace prize for her work. She will be joined by **Rozin Khalil Hanjool**, a 17 year old Yazidi who lives in the UK and has been a strong champion and campaigner for the thousands of Yazidi women who have been kidnapped by Daesh.
